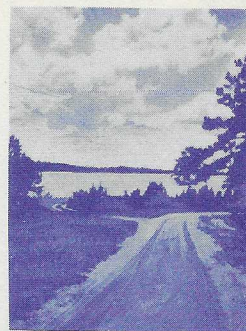

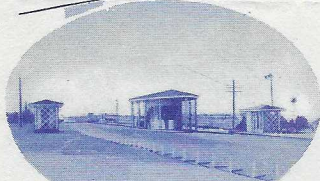

we fall out for maneuvers tomorrow to
explain something to you.

As you know by now, I have had
a change of station. Before leaving
Alexandria, La. I drew the money out

you a second thought because it
