I have put off writing to you until I could give you my new address. I want to thank you for the swell box you sent to me for Christmas. I wasn't the only one to like it because when I opened it up Christmas Eve the boys gathered in and sure helped me eat it up.

I have been moved here to Tulsa for more training and flying. They gave us sheep lined clothes and boots but it still gets pretty cold up there in these open planes. It was about 50° all day today and a good strong wind to make it seem even colder.

How are you all making out with the ration boards and draft boards.

I sure would like to hear from some
of you.

I will send in my dues at the
end of this month when I get paid. the
only trouble of this being paid by the
month is that it is a little late.

I have to get my nose back in
the books so will have to close this
short note now. Thank you all

again for the swell Xmas box.
